



Testing with Bluetooth Keyboard on iOS

The easiest way to interact with a website or application is to use QuickNav with VoiceOver. QuickNav mimics the swipes in VoiceOver on iOS and provides easy access to Rotor. Turn on Quick Nav to control VoiceOver using the arrow keys. Quick Nav is off by default. Activate the Quick Nav mode, by pressing the right and left arrow simultaneously (move backward and forward through focusable elements).

Key Command	Action
Control – Down Arrow	Select the last item
Control – Up Arrow	Select the first item
Left Arrow – Down Arrow	Stop interacting with content
Right Arrow – Down Arrow	Start interacting with content
Left Arrow	Select previous item
Option – Arrow Key	Scroll in the direction pressed
Right Arrow	Select the next item
Right Arrow + Left Arrow	Activates Quick Nav mode by pressing this keys simultaneously. This will move backward and forward through focusable elements.
Shift – Arrow Key	Move the cursor in the direction pressed
Single-letter Quick Nav for the web	You can also use the number keys on an Apple Wireless Keyboard to dial a phone number in Phone or enter numbers in Calculator.
Down Arrow – Up Arrow	Tap the highlighted item
Left Arrow – Up Arrow	Move the rotor to the left
Right Arrow – Up Arrow	Move the rotor to the right
H	Move to next heading
L	Move to next link
R	Move to next text field
B	Move to next button
C	Move to next form control
I	Move to next image
S	Move to next static text
X	Move to the next list
M	Move to the next element of the same type
1 - 6	Move to the next heading level that corresponds to the number pressed
